

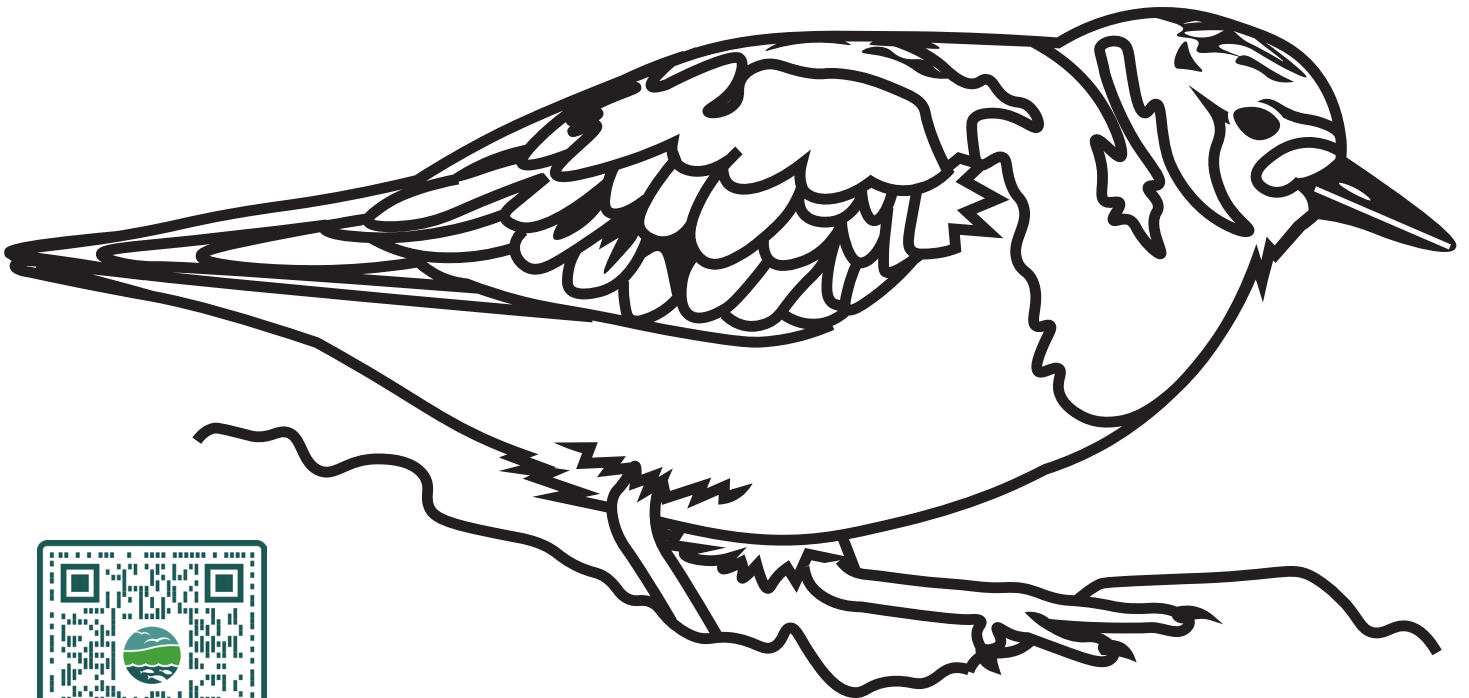
MEET MANOMET'S SHOREBIRDS

Ruddy Turnstone

The Ruddy Turnstone is a tough little shorebird that loves the beach. It gets its name because it flips over rocks and shells to find food underneath. It is also a very tough defender of its nest, known to chase off large gulls and even caribou!
